How do I set up my Interactive Journal Notebook (INY)?

Page numbering--

“Mirror pages” get the same number. So, let’s say entry 15 is a grammar lesson on commas. The **Left Side** is 15 and the **Right Side** is 15, too. If the entry needs multiple pages to fit all your work, then we would label the first “mirror pages” 15a/15a, then the second pages 15b/15b, etc.

Front Outside Cover--

Label with **YOUR NAME**, APLIT, Burnett

Front Inside Cover--

Blank—or draw something happy

DO NOT START NUMBERING PAGES UNTIL ASSIGNMENT #1

Page facing inside cover--

THIS document (3 pages), flip-up method (staple both pages at top)

Next 2 pages--

Left Side: Table of Contents #1-20 (attached)

Right Side: Table of Contents #21-40 (attached)

START NUMBERING PAGES: PAGE #1--Assignment #2--details below

Assignment #1. APLIT Handbook, Vocabulary, Signature pages

1. Print the following for your INY:
 - "Table of Contents"
 - "Summer Assignments/Supplies/Notebook"
 - "Short Story"
2. If you can, PRINT the APLIT Handbook (31 pages); **if not**, just use the digitized version. You will REFER to many of the pages in the APLIT Handbook for Assignments #2 and #3. **I will print it for you on first day.**
3. If you can, PRINT the Quizlet vocabulary (10 pages); **if not**, just use the digitized version. **I will print it for you on first day.**
 - a. "APLIT Handbook" (attached). **This will be a sort-of textbook throughout the course**
 - b. **Quizlet Vocabulary:** Use the definitions and examples that I have provided on **quizlet.com**, search: **APLIT Terms** by: **andreambu— alphabetize. To PRINT--** click "Print"; then click "small mode." **You WILL be tested on these words throughout the year.**
 - c. **Study the first 28 words of flashcards (Ad Misericordiam-Atmosphere)--You WILL have a quiz the first week back.**

Assignment #2. How To Read Literature Like a Professor by Thomas C. Foster

1. Read *How To Read Literature Like a Professor* by Thomas C. Foster **ISBN-13: 978-0062301673**
2. In your INY, hand write **5 bullet points** detailing the highlights of **EACH** chapter. Draw a line under each section and label the chapter number and title in the margin. You should be able to fit approximately 4-5 chapters per page in INY. You WILL refer to this OFTEN throughout the year! Do NOT copy from anyone or anything! Do this yourself. You WILL BE TESTED the first week.

In INY Page #1-Left Side:

Foster Bullet Points: Chapters 1-5ish

Page #1 Right Side:

Foster Bullet Points: Chapters 6-10ish

Next page #1-Left Side:

Foster Bullet Points: Chapters 11-15ish

Page #1-Right Side: Foster Bullet Points: Chapters 16-20ish
Next page #1-Left Side: Foster Bullet Points: Chapters 21-25ish
Page #1-Right Side: Foster Bullet Points: Chapters 26-30ish

Assignment #3. Novels: Read the following novel according to your last name:

***You will want to BUY your book so that you can annotate.**

***You are encouraged to read all of the books if you have time, but not required; they are amazing works.**

1st-*Their Eyes Were Watching God* by Zora Neale Hurston (A-C)

2nd- *Mrs. Dalloway* by Virginia Woolf (D-G)

3rd- *Frankenstein* by Mary Shelley (H-L)

4th- *Pride and Prejudice* by Jane Austen (M-O)

5th-*Hard Times* by Charles Dickens (P-R)

6th-*Invisible Man* by Ralph Ellison (S-T)

7th- *Call it Sleep* by Henry Roth (U-Z)

- 1. Annotate the book (this is required for a grade)--**follow the “Annotation...,” “Reflection/Critical Analysis Guidelines” found on pages 1, 3-4 of the APLIT Handbook. *You may use sticky notes or just write directly onto the pages
- 2. In INY, complete a hand-written SIFTD/TPPSSC Analysis** (page 3 in APLIT Handbook). This can be bullet points, but be as thorough as possible. For the “T”--**Tone**, choose words from the list found on pages 4-5 in APLIT HANDBOOK
- 3. In INY, complete a hand-written Reflection/Critical/Literary Analysis.** Use the notes from tasks 1 & 2 above. This should be **3** pages long and should be your fresh insight, thoughts, epiphanies, questions, memorable moments, etc. about the book. **DO NOT SUMMARIZE!!**
- 4. In INY, complete a comparison analysis with one of the chapters from Foster’s *How To Read Literature Like a Professor*.** Clearly state the chapter from Foster and then analyze how your novel showcases his theories. 2 pages.

In INY PAGE #2-Left Side: SIFTD/TPPSSC
Page #2 Right Side: Reflection/Critical Analysis, 3 pages
Page #2 Right & Left Sides: continued...
Page #2 Left & Right Sides: Comparison to Foster’s text

(number all pages of this assignment Page #2--you should have 6 total/3 Left sides and 3 Right sides)
